Kary Zicafoose made a motion to approve the October 6, 2009.

President's Report. Ms. Best presented ideas for events for the rest of the 2009/2010. No one has signed up for appropriations. An appropriations committee needs to be formed.

Principal's Report/Mary Ford. FTE count period was in October and we are going to be receiving funds for 1,033 students. The PTA needs to start looking into other ways to hold a fall event that is less taxing on families and volunteers.

Treasurer Report. A hard copy of the Treasurer's report is in the MCE PTA 2009/2010 binder. The bank statement balance as of October 30, 2009 is \$20,987.91. Online banking has been set up as of November 1, 2009.
